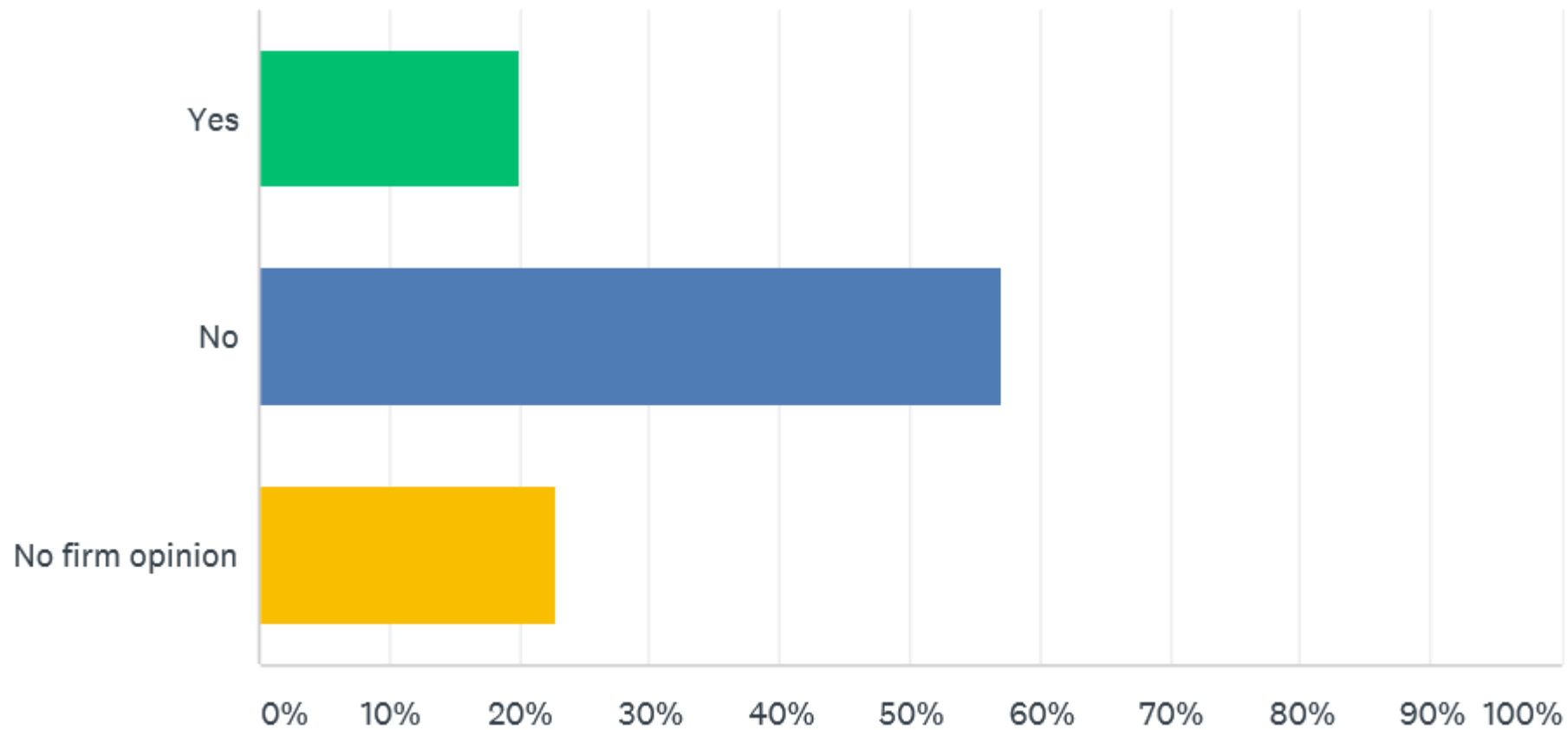

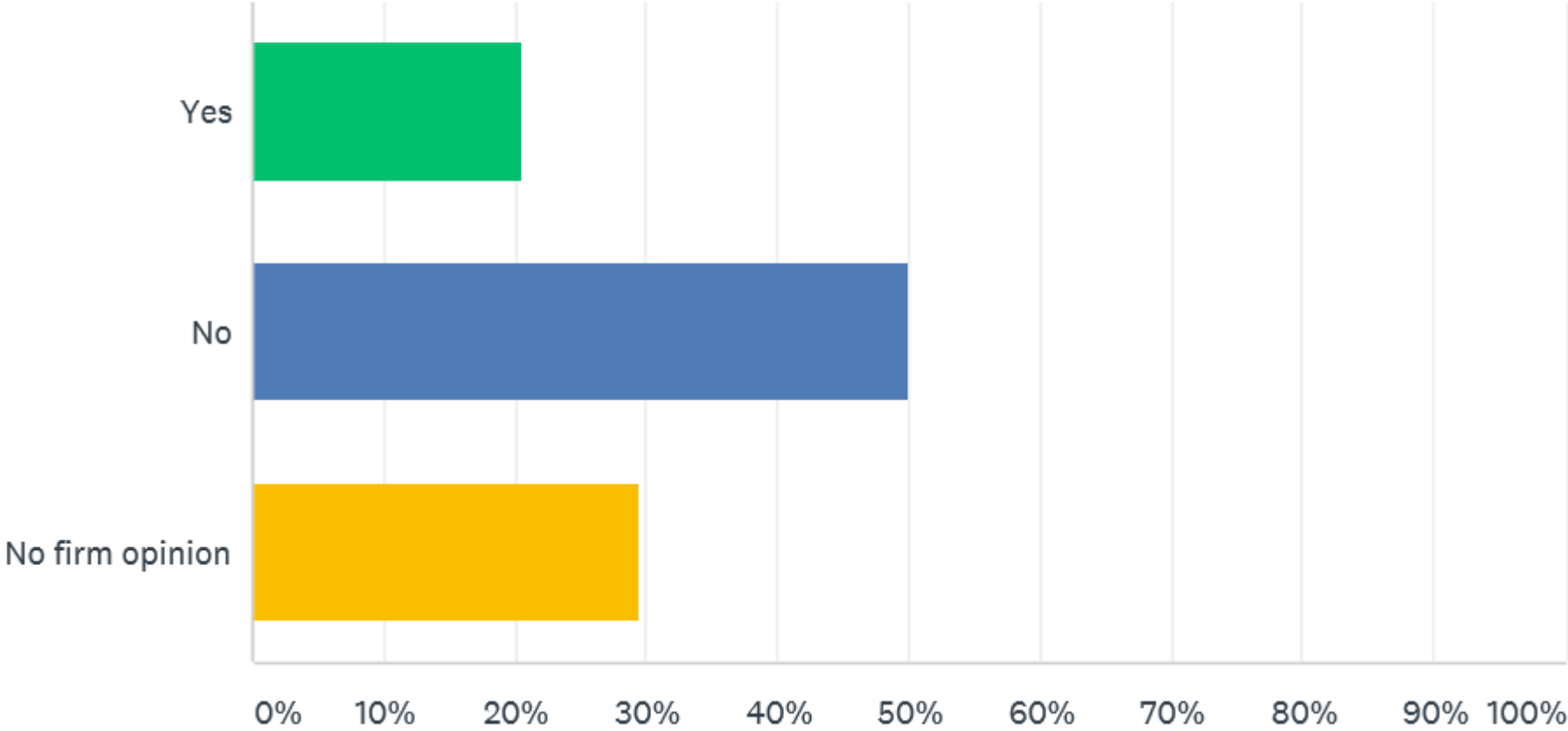
Do you support a strictly delineated institutional right of evocation by the Council for mergers in sectors declared to have industrial policy importance?

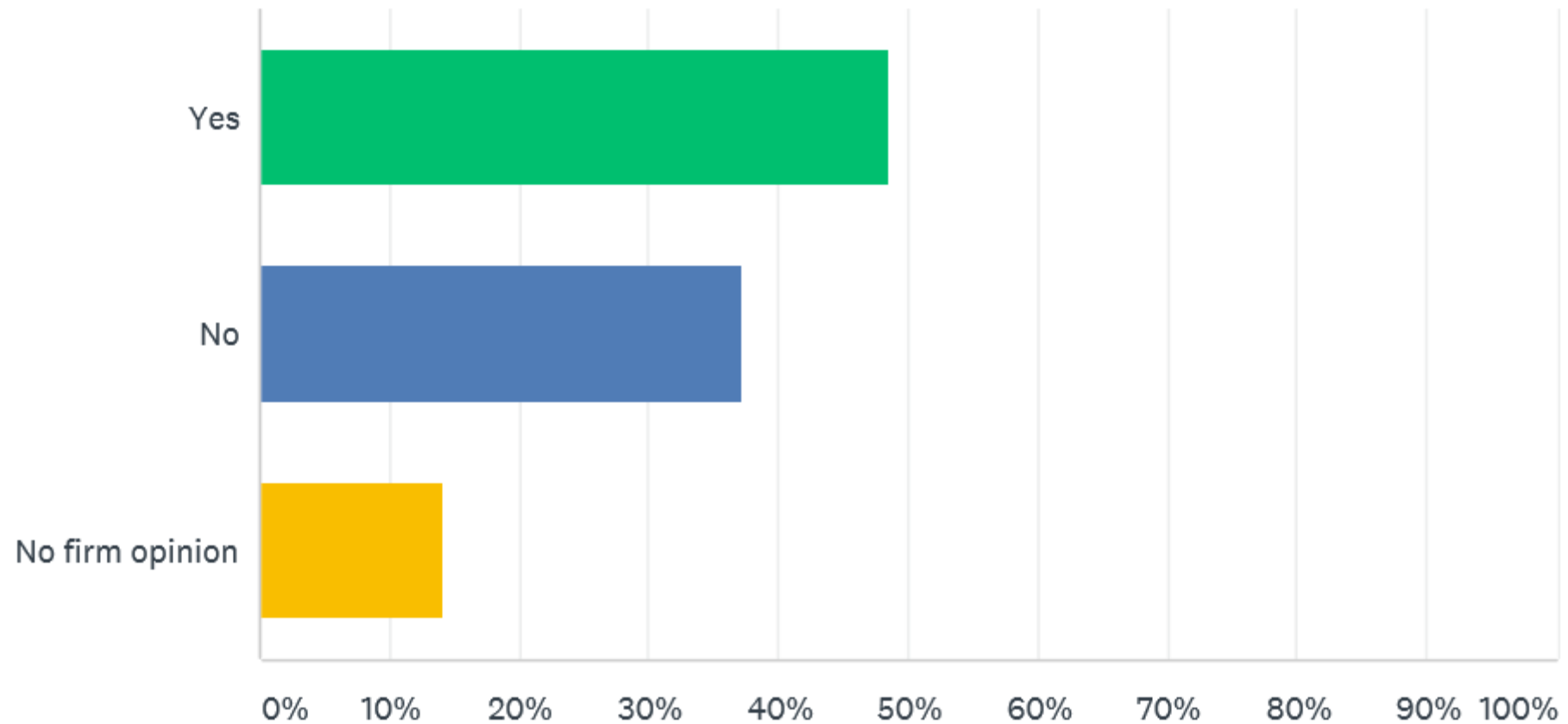

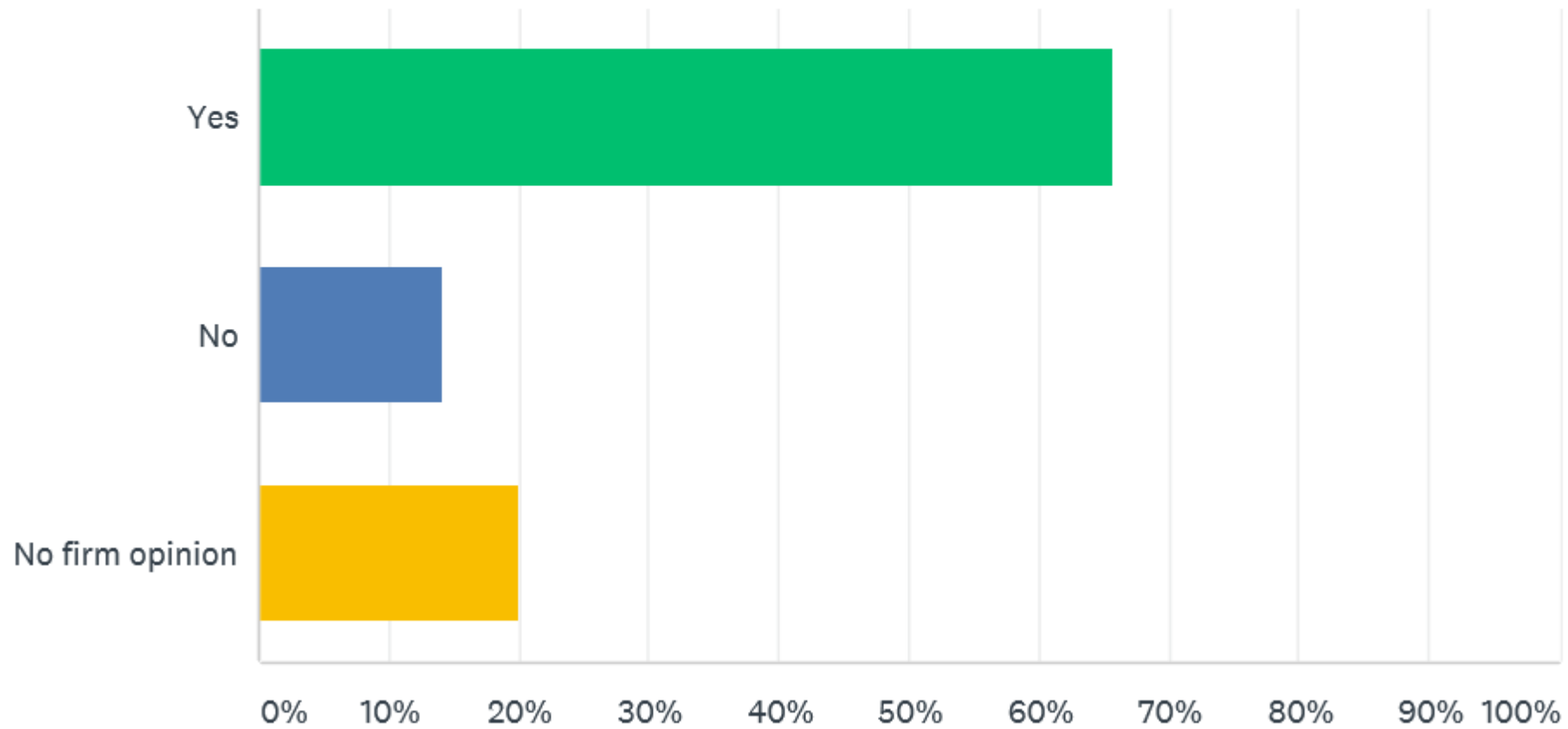
Do you support a longer time horizon of 5-7 years for counterfactual assessment under the EUMR?

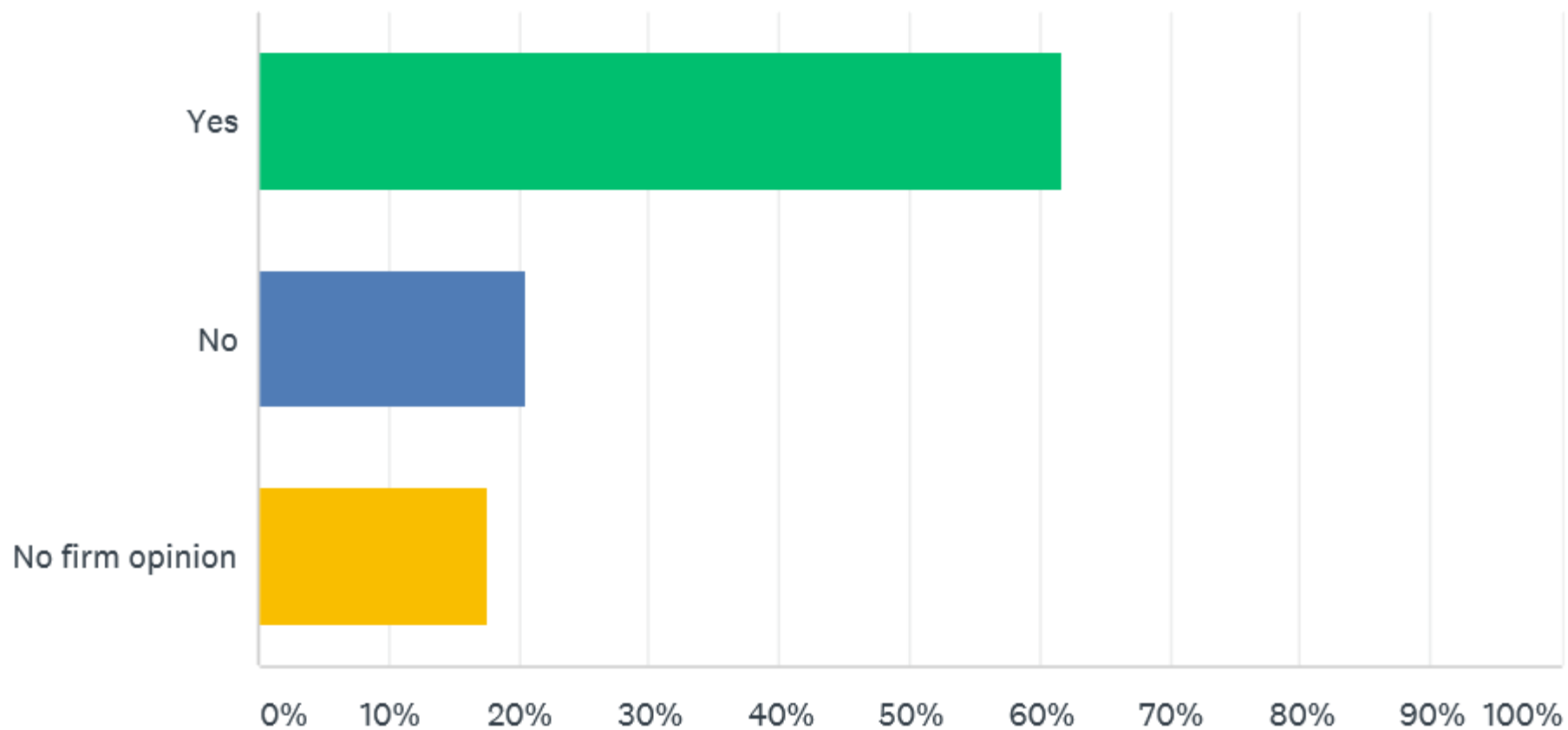
Should there be more emphasis on potential competition under the EUMR?
