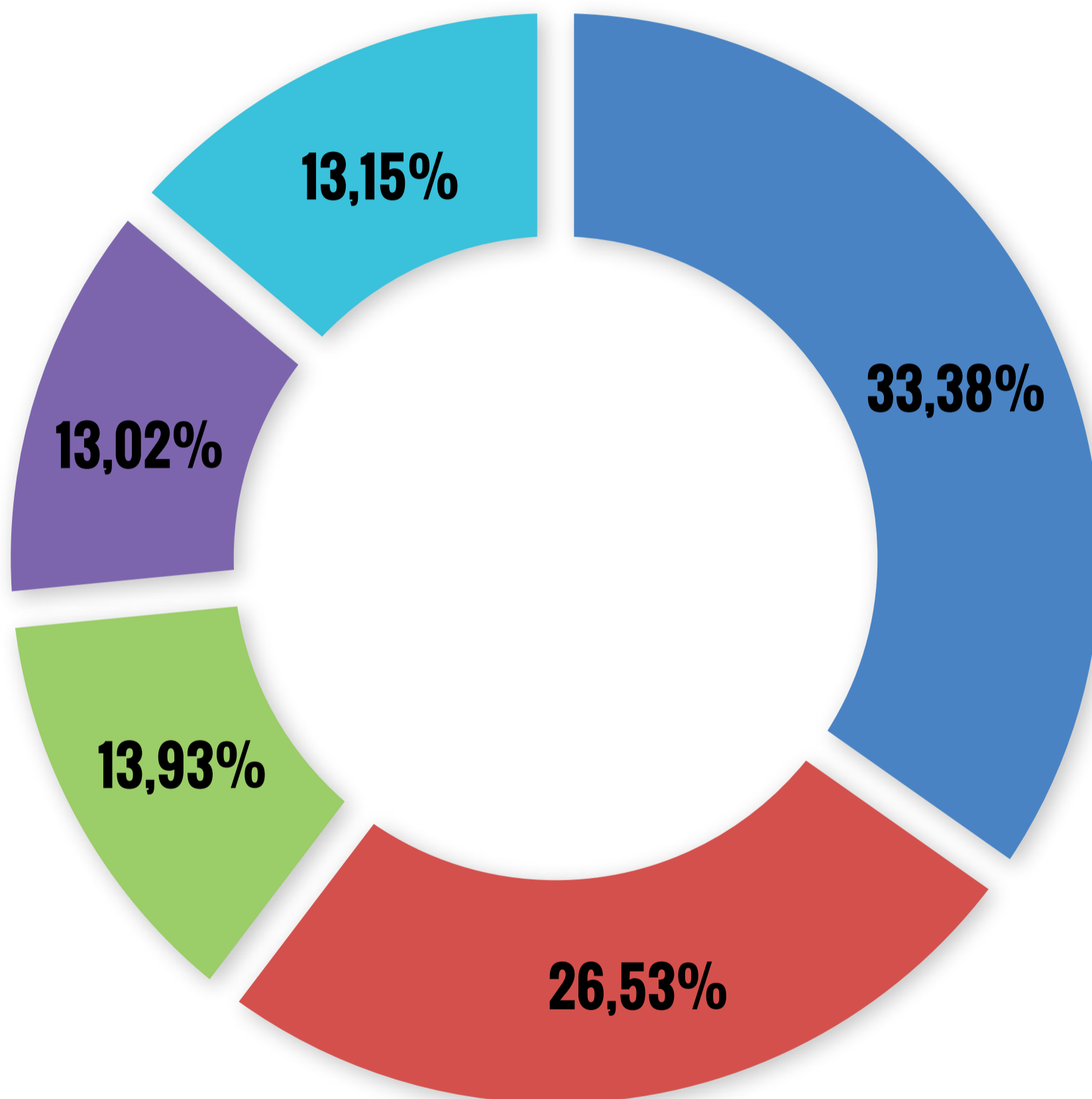

SOUP DAY



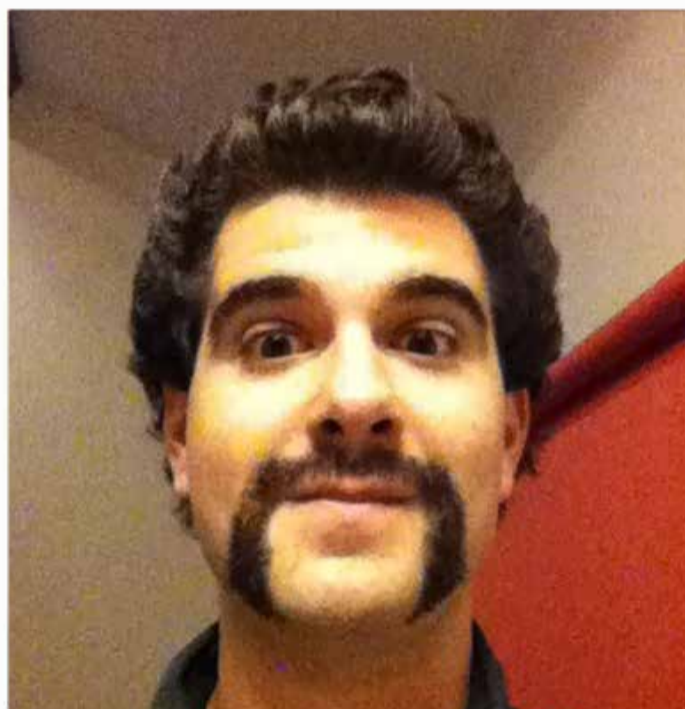

FELTING WORKSHOP



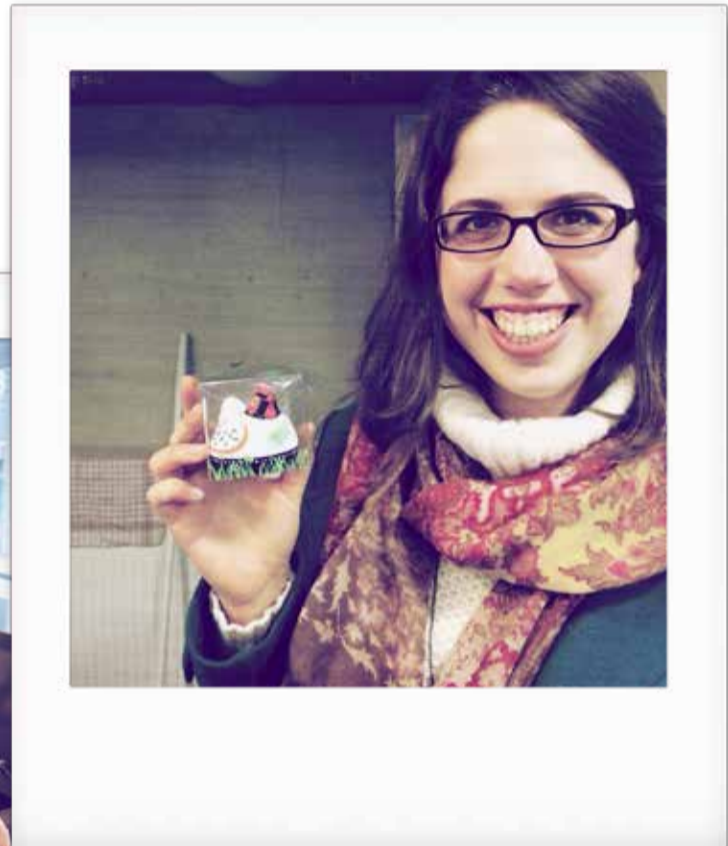
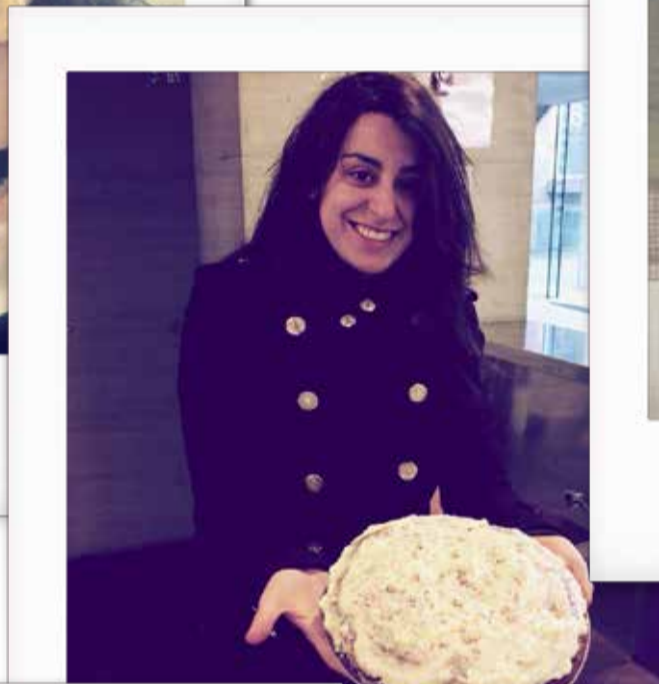
What we did A felting workshop was organized by Renée Maeyaert and we actively helped in finding participants.

UKRAINIAN CAUSE



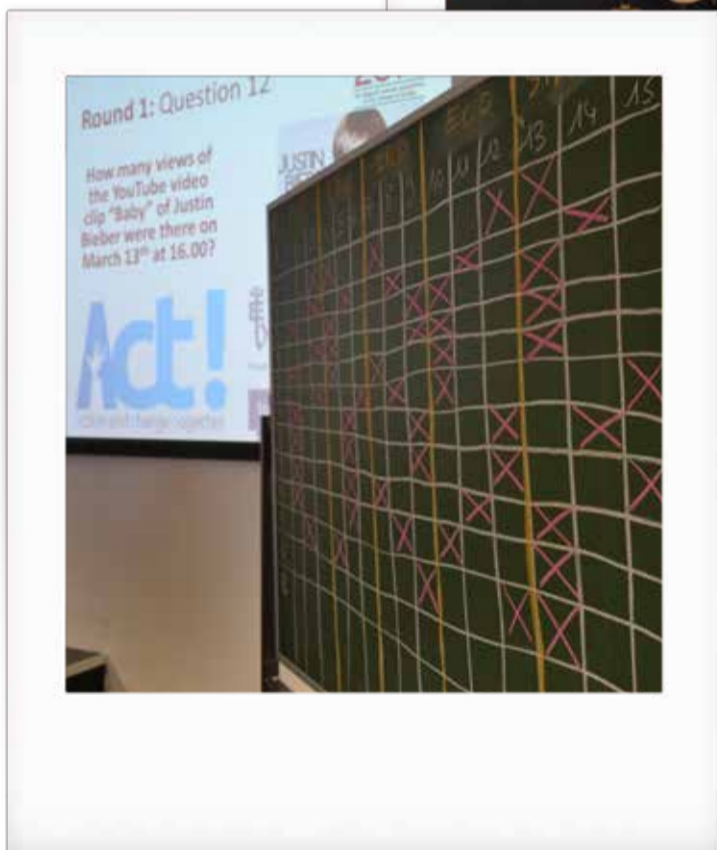
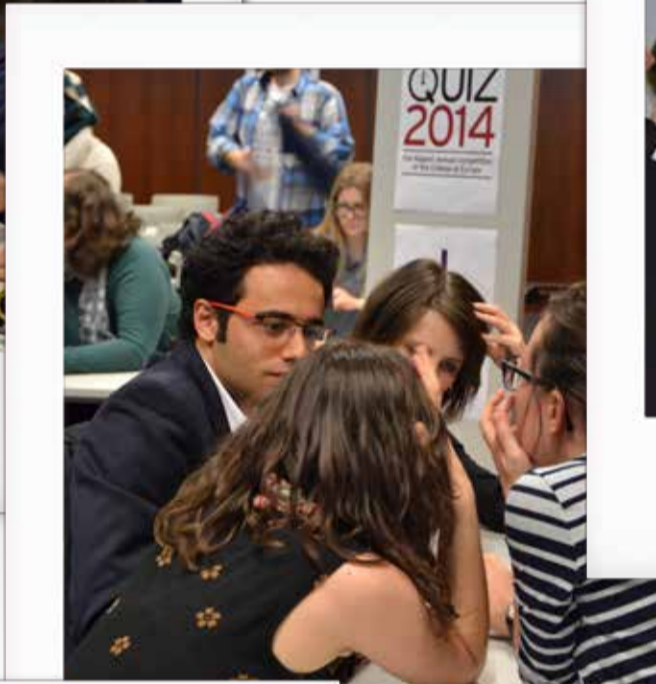
What we did Once more, in partnership with the student café Phoenix, we sold cakes that students and administration cooked for free and offered to the Ukrainian cause.

DWARS DOOR BRUGGE



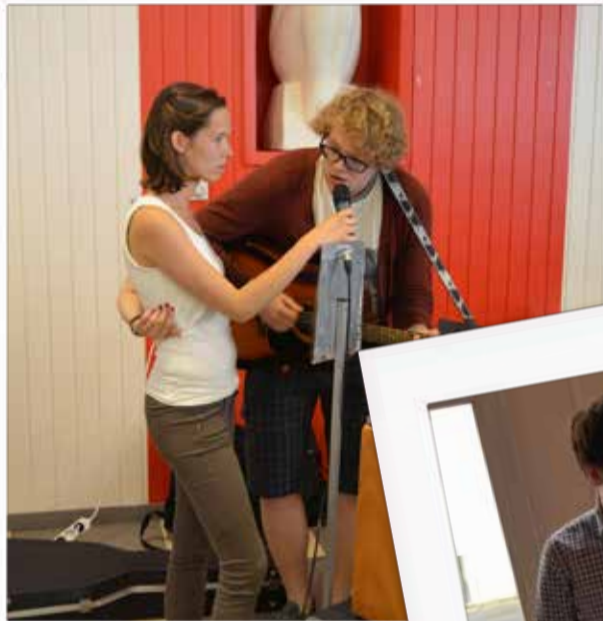
What we did We participated in the Dwars Door Bruges Race organized by the city of Bruges and raised funds through the purchase of T-shirts sold by the association GoAhead!
