Or detailed research

1. Add several keywords, authors etc.
2. Add rows to specify your research more.
3. Look for a specific format (book, article)
4. Specify your source (check the database)
5. Broader : look in libraries worldwide if we do not have any materials on your topic, and post a request for an Interlibrary loan.




