The Russian invasion of Ukraine, the pressing need for a green transition, the question of democratic control over new technologies, and the on-going pandemic all loom over the European Union.

We recommend addressing topical issues such as, but not limited to, the following:

- (Geo)Political, economic, and social dimensions of the Russian invasion of Ukraine
- The role of artificial intelligence in EU policies and strategic planning
- EU health policy post-Covid 19
- Economic dimensions of geopolitics (state aid, NextGenEU)

Contributions are accepted on a rolling basis. They may be submitted in English or French. The copyright remains with the authors. Each contribution will be reviewed by College faculty.
