CALL FOR PAPERS

Purpose

A College of Europe Policy Brief (CEPOB) is a short paper dealing with a topical policy challenge related to European Union affairs. It starts from the analysis of this challenge and provides scientific insights as evidence base for policy choices.

The series is aimed at contributing to the policy-making processes in the EU. College of Europe Policy Briefs speak to a broad audience, including policy-makers from the EU institutions and (EU and non-EU) national institutions, representatives of international organisations, the private sector and civil society, as well as scholars and students.

Call for Contributions

The EU's external action has become increasingly sectoral in nature, with various policy areas - including trade, climate change, water, energy, migration, digitalization, science, culture, education, etc. - shaping the Union's approach to global governance. This development has given rise to new challenges and opportunities for the EU's role as a global actor.

To elucidate these challenges and opportunities, the editors of CEPOB **invite researchers to submit contributions that explore the different dimensions of the EU's sectoral diplomacies**, including:

- The coherence and effectiveness of the EU's sectoral diplomacies and their implementation in different regions of the world;
- The interplay between different sectors of EU external action (e.g. digitalization and

climate change) and the implications for the Union's global role;

- The role of EU institutions, Member States, and non-state actors in shaping the Union's sectoral diplomacies;
- The impact of external actors - including third countries, international organizations, and non-state actors - on the EU's sectoral policies;
- The implications of current global challenges - such as environmental degradation or health pandemics - on the EU's sectoral diplomacies.

Submission

Contributions are accepted on a rolling basis. They may be submitted in English or French. The copyright remains with the authors. Each contribution will be reviewed by College faculty.
