GRANTS FOR US SCHOLARS

Fulbright-Schuman Distinguished Scholar Award at the College of Europe

Every other year (in rotation with the European University Institute in Florence), the Fulbright Schuman Programme funds a three- to five-month fellowship for mid-career and senior US academics to pursue independent research and teach graduate courses. Candidates are expected to hold a Ph.D. and have several years of teaching experience. Application deadline is 15 September.

Fulbright Schuman European Union Affairs Program

This three- to nine- month grant allows early- or mid-career academics, professionals, or senior academics to conduct policy-oriented research that addresses topics of common importance for the US-EU relationship and/or EU affairs. Application deadline is 15 September.

Fulbright Scholar Award in NATO Security Studies

US scholars studying NATO are eligible to apply for this four-month grant to conduct research and teach an elective course at the College of Europe. Applications are accepted in a number of fields of study. Given the unique nature of this award, applications in areas with a connection to NATO are highly encouraged, including but not limited to: cybersecurity, military history, nuclear disarmament and non-proliferation, peace and security, security studies, and transatlantic studies. Application deadline is 15 September.
