



Lizza Bomassi is the deputy director of Carnegie Europe, the European center of the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace. In that capacity she is responsible for harmonizing the organization's strategic and operational priorities and managing relations with partner organizations in Europe. She also oversees Carnegie Europe's Asia work and carries out research and writing on Europe-Asia related issues. Prior to joining Carnegie, Bomassi helped found the International Task Force on Preventive Diplomacy which went on to establish the Parliamentarians Network for Conflict Prevention and the Global Conference on Preventive Action. In the early 2000s Bomassi worked with Save the Children on emergency relief and humanitarian assistance programs in Pakistan and Afghanistan. Bomassi holds a master's degree from the London School of Economics and is fluent in English and French.
